AUSTRALIAN G. C.

The Australian G. C. opened their new links club-house at Kensington on Saturday afternoon, when 200 ladies and gentlemen competed. Fifty ladies played over their own nine-hole course, which proved to be more difficult than was anticipated, as the result showed. Over one hundred and fifty men played over the long course.

In view of the importance of the event, some information regarding the history of the club should prove interesting. The Australian G.C. was the first golf club to be formed in New South Wales. In the early eighties, when the club was formed, the membership list included such well-known names as the Hon. H. C. Dangar, the Hon. W. R. Campbell, J. R. Street, and about 30 others. The Municipal Council of Sydney granted the club permission to play on a portion of Moore Park. It is interesting to note that in 1884 Mr. C. H. Cadogan presented a cup (the Cadogan Cup), to be played for there annually, unless won twice in succession, when it was to become the property of the winner. This cup is still being contested for, the present holder being Dr. Gordon Craig. The first five winners were Messrs. Hamilton Osborne, A. Gray, A. C. Blackburn, C. C. Griffiths, and Dr. E. Fairfax Ross. In 1888 the club lost its links, and was unable to find fresh ground until 1896, when a few of the original members and others decided to utilise the accumulated funds of the old club, and formed new links in Queen's Park, Waverley. By this time the Sydney Golf Club (now the R.S.G.C.) had started on links at Bondi, and a friendly but keen rivalry existed between the two clubs, with the result that today Sydney golfers are provided with two first-class golf links, each with an up-to-date club-house. The rapid increase in the membership of the A.G.C. necessitated a removal, and the now famous Botany links were secured for a term of seven years, during which time the first professional match, two Australian championship meetings, including the first open championship of Australasia, were decided on these links. Before the expiration of this lease the club decided to form fresh links at Kensington, to secure which a company was formed amongst the members of the club. The necessary land was purchased, and the members of the club now look forward to an era of uninterrupted tenure of ideal links within 25 minutes of Sydney. The club is to be congratulated upon the fact that for the first time in the history of golf in Australia two competitions, with so many players, could be successfully carried out on the same day and at the same time. Over 300 visitors were present at the club-house during the afternoon, and general admiration was expressed for the club-house and links by the visitors and players.
